LUNCH OPTIONS

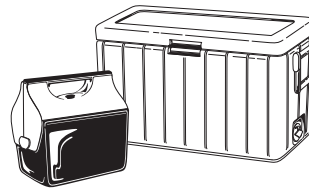
- Subs, pizza, soft drinks, juices and snacks are available at the Subway Café. You can pre-order lunch through the Museum. Please look for the order form that will be included in your confirmation package. Orders must be placed at least seven (7) days prior to your scheduled visit.

- The Explore Store and vending machines also offer snacks, ice cream, soda and water.

NOTE: For students who bring their lunch, the school should provide coolers that must remain on the bus.

Other items that must be left on the bus:

- Backpacks
- Lunch containers
- Outer clothing, such as jackets



CHAPERONE GUIDELINES

- One chaperone is **REQUIRED** for every ten students in grades 1-12 and one for every five students in Pre-K and Kindergarten.
- Each adult must be assigned to chaperone a specific group of children. Adult chaperones **MUST** stay with their group at all times to ensure the itinerary is followed. Inadequately supervised groups or groups causing disturbances will be asked to leave without a refund.
- A chaperone is any teacher or adult accompanying the group.
- All **RESERVED** chaperones are not charged for the exhibit portion of any trip. Any additional adults will be charged the student rate of \$6.50 for exhibit entry at the door.
- All **RESERVED** chaperones are charged \$3.00 for the IMAX® portion of any trip. Any additional adults will be charged the student rate of \$6.50 at the door.
- Schools are responsible for collecting monies from chaperones to pay in one transaction.
- Membership benefits are not applicable on group reservations.
